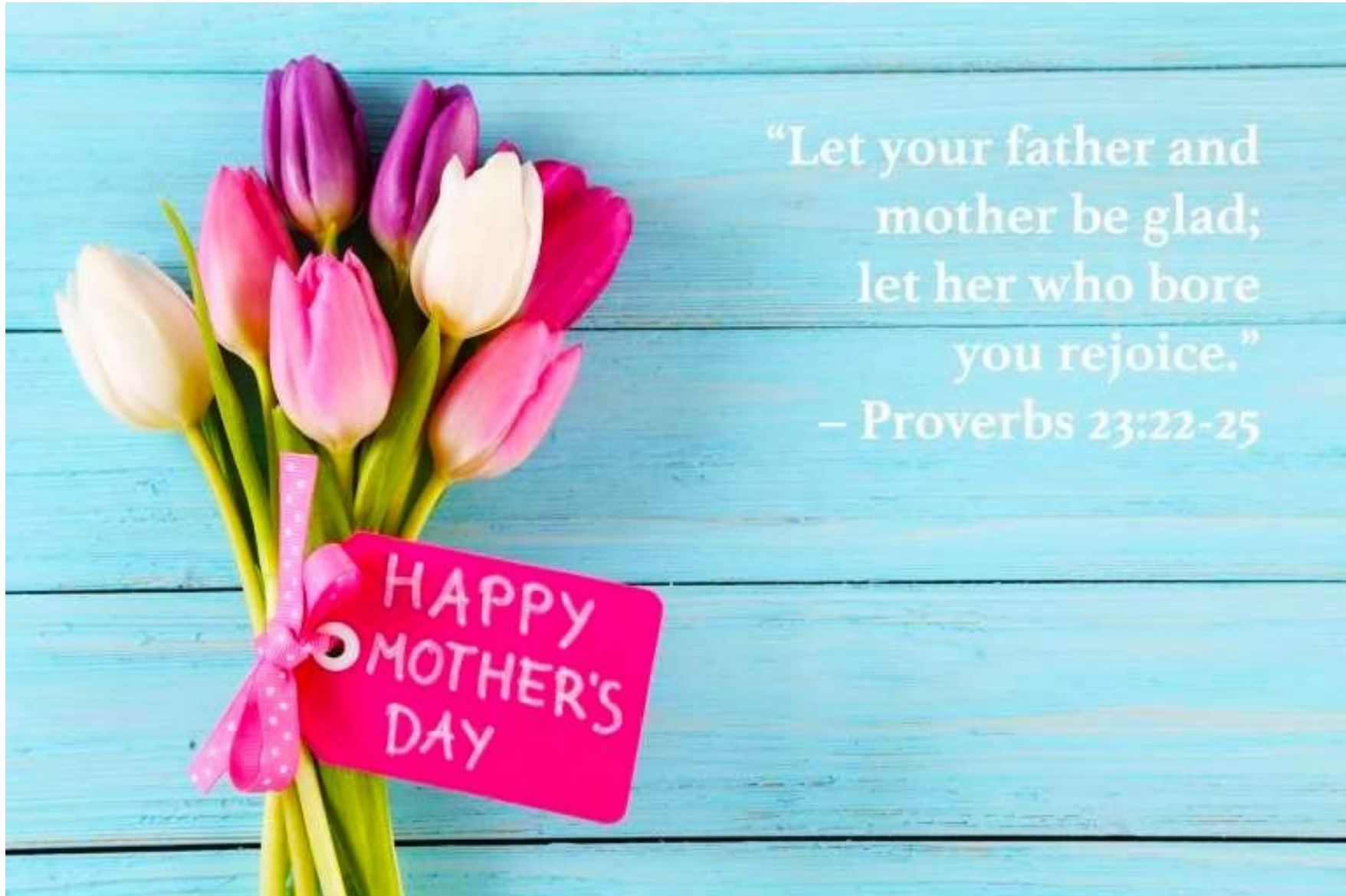

We are asking each student to bring at least \$1 to help support this important cause.

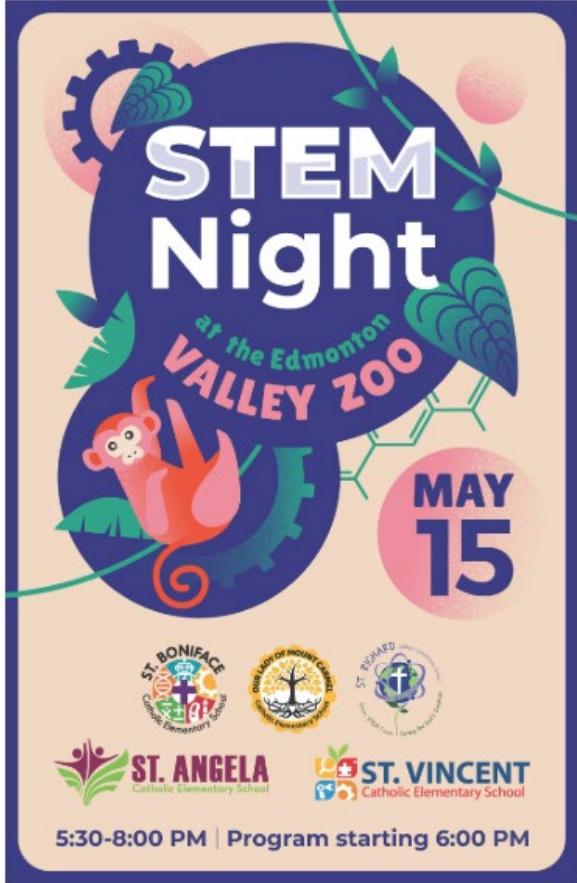
