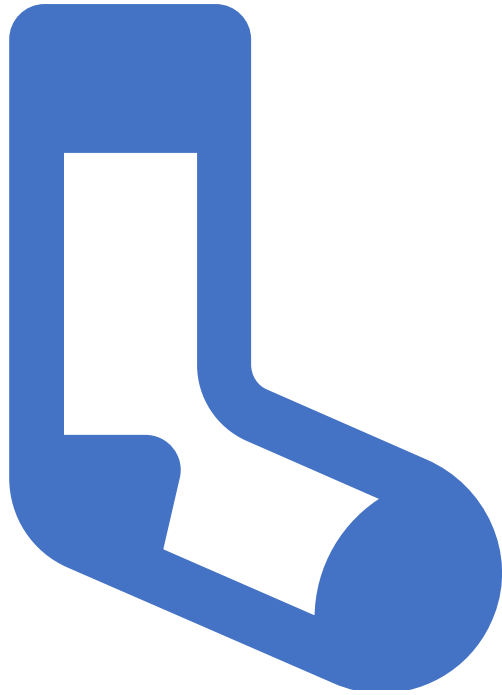

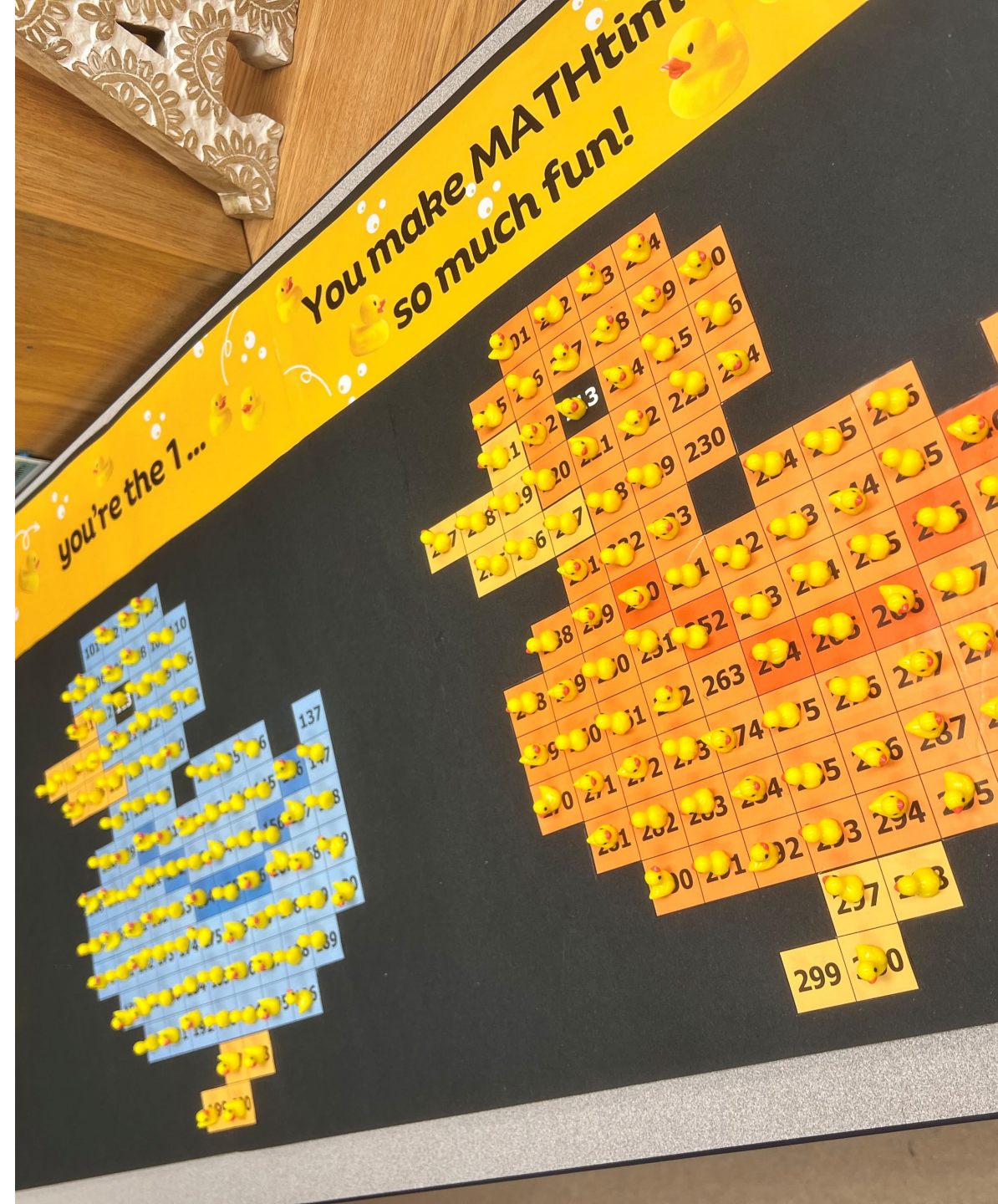


Social Justice - Socks for the Homeless

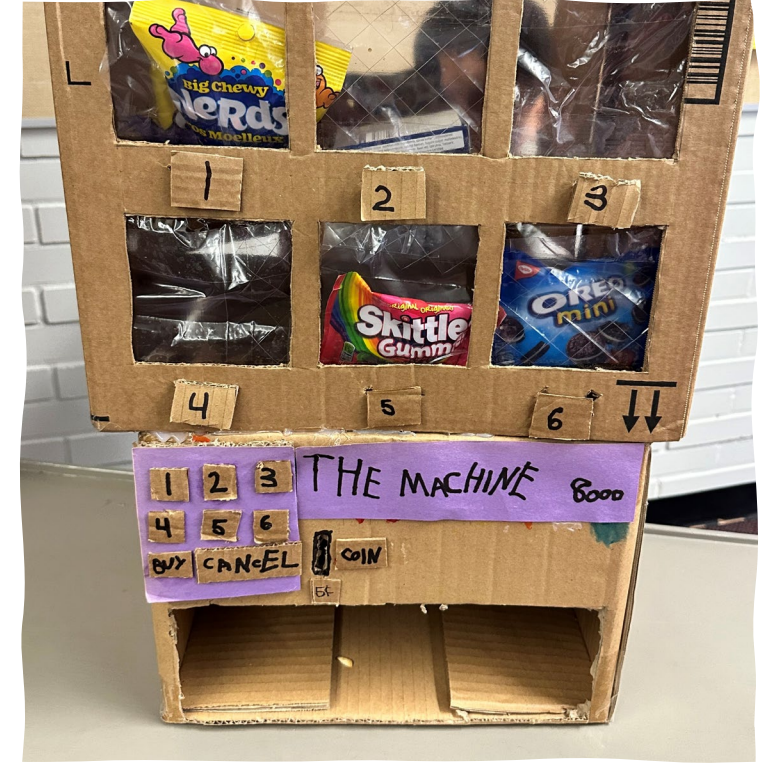
Laudato Si' Residency

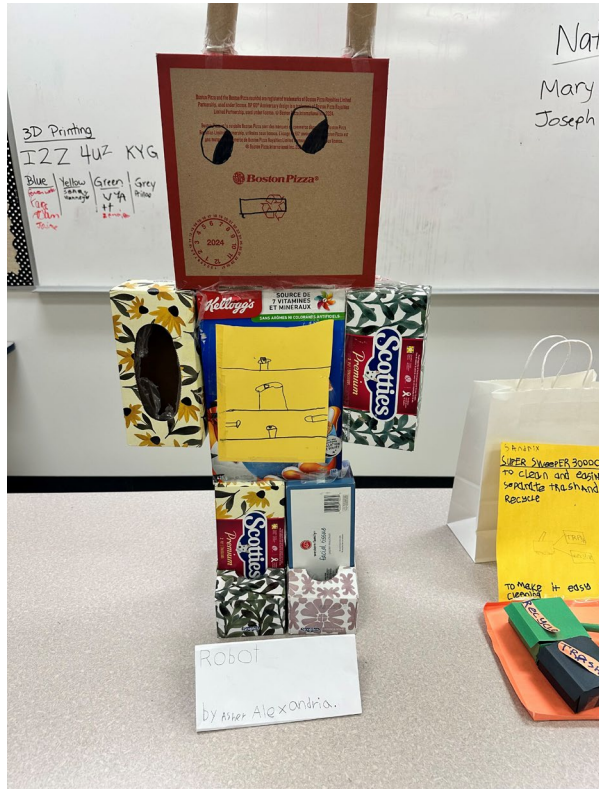
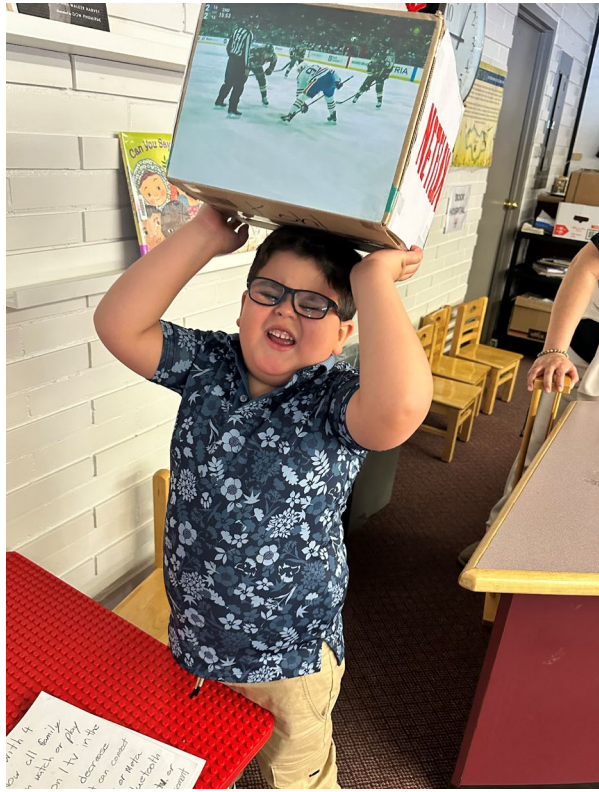

Storm Water Ponds
