St. Edmund Parish Confirmation Update:

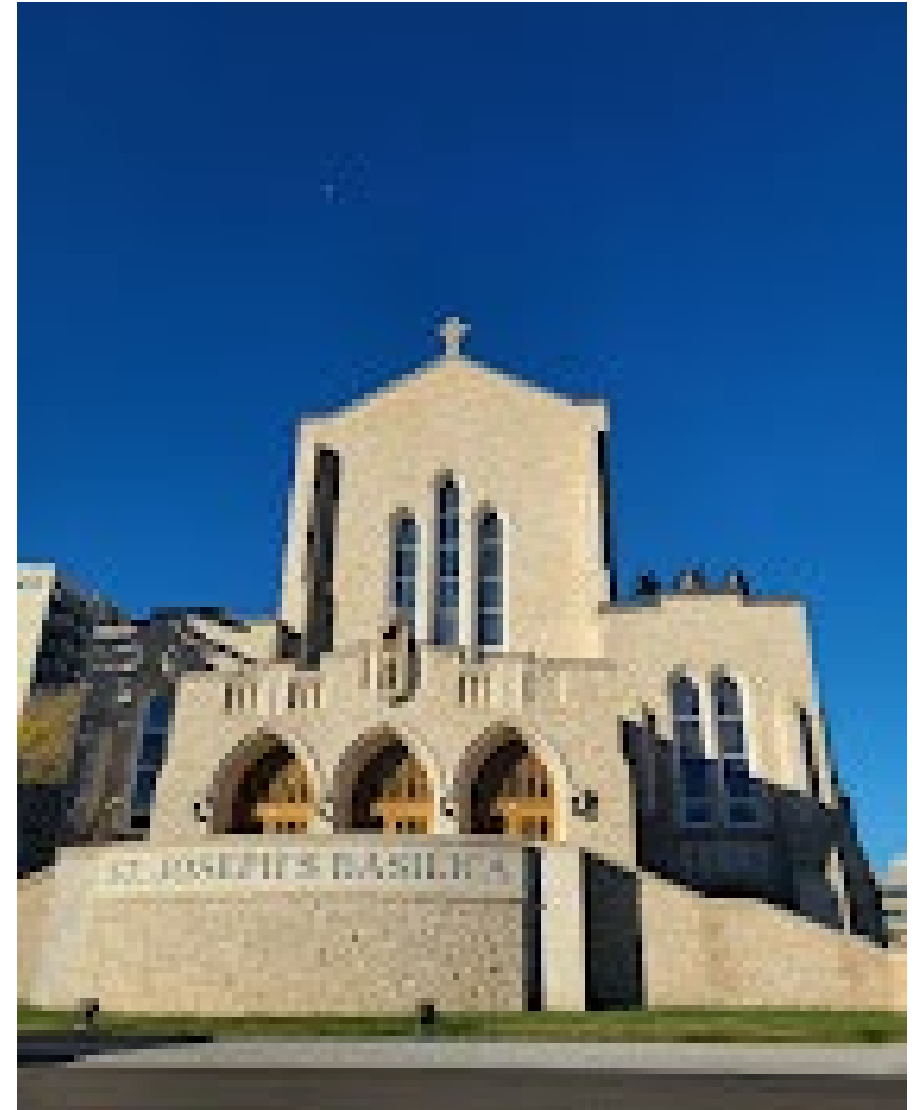
St. Edmund Parish is accepting registrations for children in Grade 6 and Junior High (approximately aged 12 years old and older) for the sacrament of Confirmation. Confirmation is the sacrament whereby a child, who has already been baptized and received their first Eucharist, completes their full initiation into the Catholic Church. *(Children who may still need to complete the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Eucharist will be helped to do so prior to being Confirmed.)*

At St. Edmund, Confirmation is scheduled for June 14, 2025. *(The first class is Saturday, November 16th, 2024 a parent information and registration session- 10 am – 12 noon.)* However, please call the parish office to speak to our Pastoral Assistant, Monica Murphy to register and get materials ((780) 455-8592).

NOVEMBER REVIEW – LIVING OUR FAITH

We will deepen our understanding of Laudato Si' through a focused residency with our Religion consultant and by increasing our time outdoors in our outdoor classroom.

As a Green STEM school, we will have a yearlong focus on caring for creation.

NOVEMBER REVIEW – LEARNING EXCELLENCE

Our teachers will make learning visible for students by posting learning goals, establishing success criteria, and providing students with feedback to help them identify strengths and areas for growth.

We will continue our home reading program and buddy reading and partner with the Edmonton Public Library to participate in their Reading Rockstars program.

We will continue to analyze our screener data to plan for targeted instruction and intervention with a particular focus on supporting our EAL learners.

Our professional learning will focus on new curriculum implementation, assessment, outdoor learning, and STEM learning to achieve excellence in curricular outcomes using a transdisciplinary planning approach.

NOVEMBER REVIEW – ORGANIZATIONAL EXCELLENCE

We will strategize with our school council to find ways to engage more parents to help continue to build a positive school community.

Lunch with the admin team meetings will be held to gather student suggestions in relation to school improvement.

A student survey was conducted to ensure that student voice is considered in learning experiences and extracurricular offerings.

We will continue to utilize Spaces EDU to provide digital portfolio updates to our families
