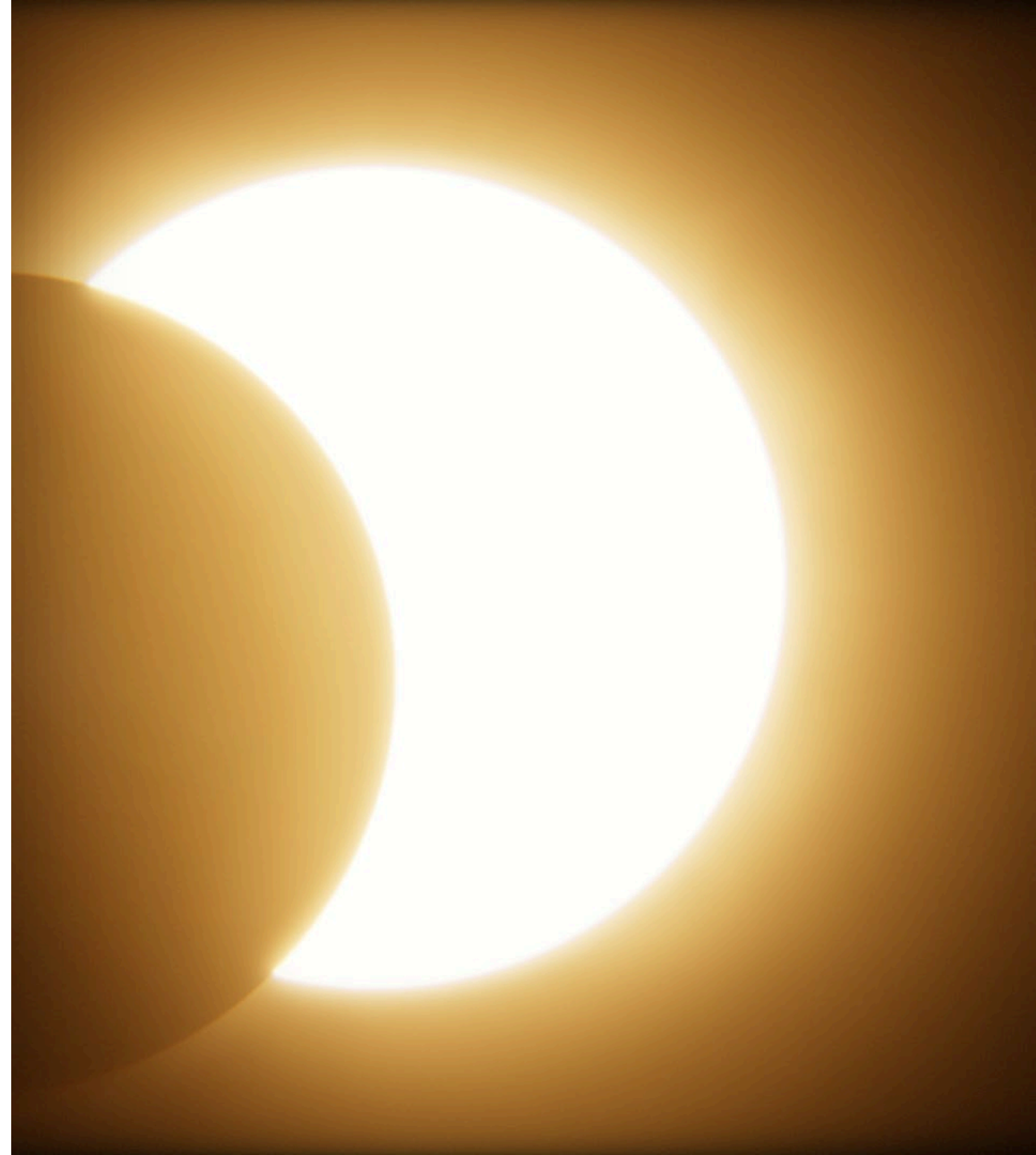
Partial Solar Eclipse

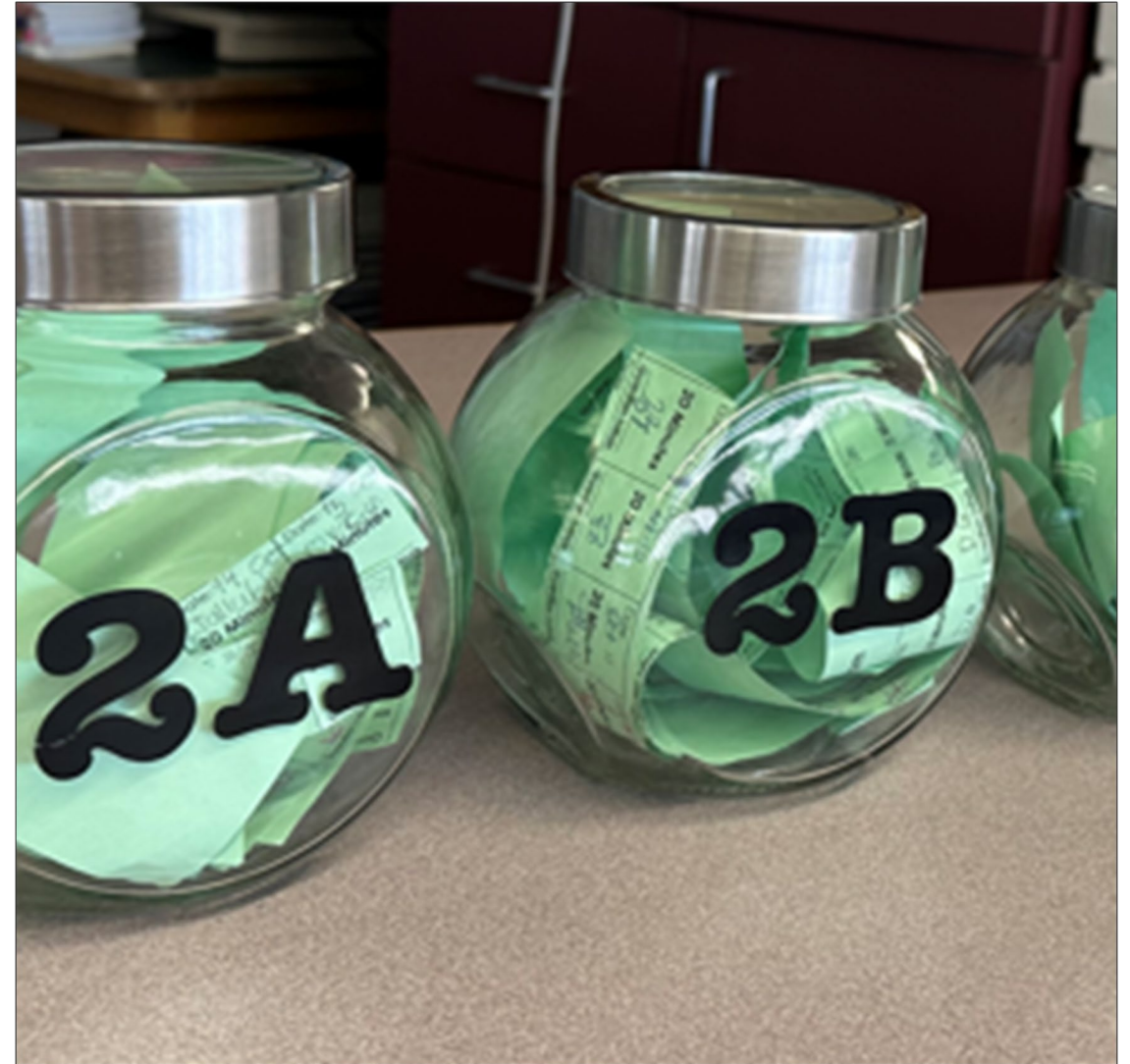
